This is carried out yearly and inputs from odd and even semesters are taken in to account. The ‘Rating Sheet for Non-teaching Staff’ is initiated by section-in-charges on yearly basis. HOD and Principal endorses their assessment on the format. Evaluation criteria includes behavior towards students/colleagues/higher ups, punctuality, discipline, willingness to accept responsibility, involvement in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities, completion of assigned works, etc. Feedback from the students, in respect of every course instructor is collected at the end of each semester, to analyze the characteristics such as, subject knowledge, communication skill, willingness to help, preparation of lessons, sincerity, punctuality, ability to maintain discipline, questions encouragement, presentation speed, general behavior and attitude, etc. If the performance of any staff is found to be below the required level setup by the College, the staff may be given training for improving their performance and /or caution to improve.</p>

	<i>Entrance test / admission criteria</i>	Admission to B. Tech. Course - Government Quota: All admissions to the B. Tech. courses through Government quota will be in accordance with agreements signed between the Government of Kerala and Self Financing Engineering College Management Association from time to time. The admissions will be carried out by the College as per the rules and regulations of Government of Kerala, APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University and AICTE. For the admission to B. Tech. course, the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) promulgates eligibility criteria of students for appearing in the Common Entrance Examination and conducts the examination. The merit list is announced by CEE and counseling/registration of option/allotment for admission to the college is done on the basis of rank obtained for the entrance test as well as any other criteria fixed by the CEE from time to time. The allotment of college and course are made to the students based on a pre-formatted plan by CEE. The CEE as per the rules and regulations of Government of Kerala and formula agreed by the Self Financing Engineering College Management Association fills up the allotted seats on the basis of merit listing.																																		
	<i>Entrance test / admission criteria</i>	Admission to B. Tech Course -Management Quota: All admissions for the management quota of B. Tech. course are carried out by the college as per the rules and regulations and the eligibility criteria of Government of Kerala, APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University and AICTE. Application form and prospectus are issued to the candidates who wish to take admission in the management quota from college office. Management quota selection is based on the criteria fixed from time to time. Admissions are made to various categories such as Tuition Fee Waver Scheme, NRI Quota and General Management Seats.

	<i>Students Activity Body</i>	A Staff advisor is nominated by the principal to coordinate all activities of the College Students' Council. The aim is to give orientation and leadership among students by organizing various extra-curricular activities. The council consists of representatives elected from all classes. Two representatives from classes having more than 35 students are elected. The term in office of the elected representatives is normally be one year. Students with sound academic and good attendance record are only eligible to contest for election. In addition, the Principal may nominate up to four representatives from students who are proficient in arts, sports, literary talents, etc., if not, properly represented by election. Under representation of girl students and non representation from SC/ST communities will also be taken in to account for such nomination. Office bearers of the students' council such as Chairperson, General Secretary, Sports /Arts Secretary, Magazine Student Editor, University Union Councilors (one or two based on student strength), etc. are elected by the representatives.
	<i>Cultural activities</i>	Cultural activity coordinator prepares the budget in consultation with the Staff adviser, for hosting cultural events within the campus. Cultural activity coordinator forms teams of staff and students to handle various responsibilities for conducting arts festival in the college. Frequent interactions and rehearsals are conducted by delegating responsibilities. Screening of likely participants is arranged to enable minimum standard during competitions. Competitions are held among the students department-wise and talents are identified. He also organizes teams of staff and students to handle various responsibilities for conducting the sports and games in the College. The students are divided in to four houses and a staff in-charge is appointed for each. Each house selects a captain. The sports and games are conducted in line with the scheduled itinerary and the winners are awarded prizes. Physical education lecturer maintains a list of talented sportsperson based on earlier performances within and outside the college. As and when inter-collegiate/inter university sports and games activities are announced, the Principal directs the Physical education lecturer to initiate necessary actions who in turn selects the team and arranges for the necessary coaching. Physical education lecturer sends the necessary applications to the organizers in consultation and approval of the Principal.
	<i>Literary activities</i>	Students are encouraged to participate in all Literary events conducted in the college and as well as in other institutions.

	<i>Magazine / Newsletter</i>	<p>College magazine is generally brought out every year to bring forth hidden literary talents of students. It can include contributions from staff and students like general articles, technical papers, poems, jokes, drawings, etc. It may contain messages from dignitaries who are well wishers of the College.</p> <p>The Principal appoints a staff editor for the publishing of the college magazine, who in turn constitutes an editorial board with staff/student representatives. Student editor, elected by the Students' council assists in bringing out the magazine. The magazine may highlight various departmental activities in the academic year, photographs of final year students, annual report by the Principal, brief reports on sports and cultural activities of students along with photographs, academic achievements of students and such other important activities of the year. The list of contributions to be published shall be decided by the editorial board. The Principal approves the same before printing. The magazine is usually released in a function arranged by the College.</p> <p>News Letters:</p> <p>The Principal appoints a news letter editor for the publishing of the college news letters periodically. Activities within the quarter are usually reported in news letters. Forth coming activities are also highlighted in the news letter. The news letter is usually circulated to neighbouring colleges and well wishers.</p>
	<i>Technical activities / TechFest</i>	Students are encouraged to participate in Tech Fests conducted by Various colleges.
	<i>Industrial Visits / Tours</i>	Regular Industrial visit / Tours are organized as per university instructions.
	<i>Alumni activities</i>	The college has an alumni association functioning with voluntary membership. All staff, former teaching staff and old students of the College are eligible to become members of the association
